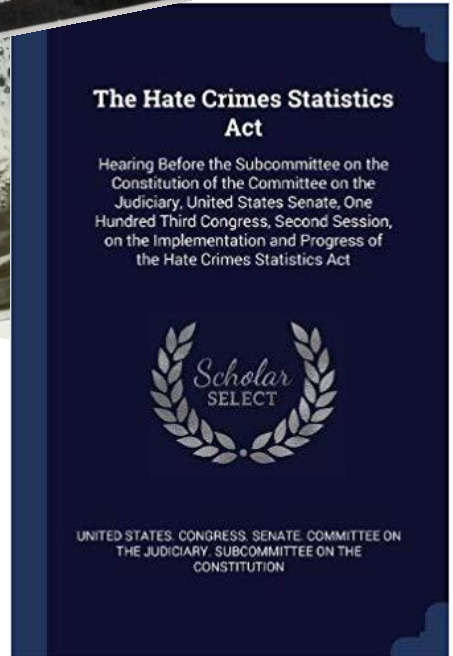
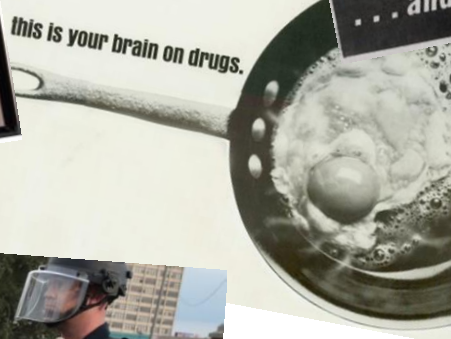


CJS 360: Social Construction of Crime
