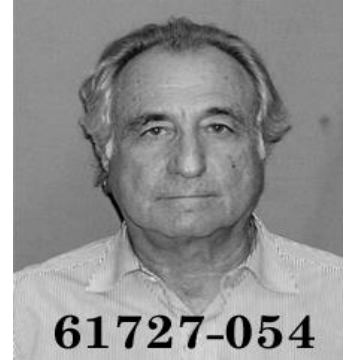

White-collar/Corporate crime, Organized crime, State crime, Environmental crime

Students will learn about crimes committed by powerful corporations, individuals, state actors, and other entities. It examines the role of power in the criminal justice system, focusing on acts that, if committed by powerless individuals, would undoubtedly be considered criminal.
